

Central New York Disc Golf Amateur Club Event Series – ('ACES')

Event information and template

Purpose:

- 1) To strengthen the Central New York Clubs through a series of one-round events with the benefits going to the overall winning club.
- 2) Provide encouragement to local club members to travel and build the Central New York disc golf scene.

Who:

All club members from:
Corning Disc Golf Club
Central New York Disc Golf Association
Disclthaca
Rochester Disc Golf Club

What:

- 4 – 1-round events, each hosted by a participating club
- 1 – final event and awards ceremony (TBD)

Format / Rules:

- Each event is one round of 18 holes
- As these are amateur events, PDGA Pro's are welcome to play for their club however their score will be handicapped to a 900 player rating. Ie: if a 960 player participates their handicap will be six strokes
- Entry fees commonly fixed at \$10; Registration: 9:00 a.m.; 10:00 a.m. Tee
- Players are intended to be members in good standing, players may not 'switch teams' during the series
- Top competitors from each club will receive prizes for each event. If a member of a club has won twice, the next best club member wins the prize.
- Points are based on the number of competitors in the event with a base point awarded per player beaten (ie if you finish ahead of 10 players – you earn 10 base points.
- Base points are worth double for all events other than your host club event; playing at your home event earns single points. Women and juniors points factor double (4x away, 2x home)
- While each individual event is to award prizes to the highest club finisher, series points will be tracked for women and juniors with awards at the final event
- All payouts will be in plastic or prizes, no cash. Clubs are encouraged to raise 'sponsorship' of prizes for the event.
- Plastic deals with custom logos are being negotiated with Discraft and Innova. I will be in touch with each club.

- We encourage a the club hold \$2 per throw, 3 for \$5 CTP contest with the winners being recorded and given the chance to throw off for a basket at the finals.
- Playing in two or more events earns the club member a series disc with logo.
- Distribution of \$10 Entry Fees:
 - \$3 to prize value, \$2 to club, \$5 to Grand Prize Fund
- If necessary, the ACES final event will be held as an ‘event within an event’ using the Central NY Championships with the following qualifiers:
 - Only those who have played in 2 or more ACES events may have their rounds count towards additional club points
 - The best round of the day for those who qualify will be tabulated similar to the series events
 - No point factor (x2) for the final event. All points single (2x for women and juniors)
- At the end of the series the winning club will be awarded a cash prize (amount of which is based on overall participation) to be used for course / club improvements.
- www.discithaca.com will serve as series host for event schedule/results/guidelines. (to be completed by end March)
- Participating clubs agree not to schedule any events

In this imaginary scenario:

Disc package prize winners (provided by Rochester Club):

Tom Mulligan – Rochester
Tom Corning – Corning
Dylan Courbat – CNYDGA
Cutter Cramton – DiscIthaca

Club Place/Points:

CNYDGA: 292
Rochester: 92*
Corning: 114
DiscIthaca: 96

* Rochester, as host, earned half as much points but placed second for the ‘day’
So let’s take a look at the numbers behind the scenes:

\$10 entry – 23 people = \$230
4 prize packages at \$69 (23x3) value *minimum*
\$46 to host club (Club takes a total of \$115 – prize \$ plus host \$)
\$115 to Grand Prize Fund

Grand prize for club on that model = 4 x \$115= \$460 for winning club.
Grand prize \$\$ can be used to fund cement tee pads, tee signs, course improvements, etc.
